
Cul-de-Sac Sign Replacement





Cul-de-Sac Sign Replacement **SUMMARY OF OVERVIEW**

October 2021

- BUDGET Cul-de-sac signs total of 53 large panels:
 - * 19 one-sided
 - * 17 two-sided
 - * additional small address signs for Cisne, Esmeralda, Tulipan, Ristra on posts
- > 3 WELCOME signs in a coordinated design, placed half block into the neighborhood from the monument signs on entry streets. Text - "Welcome to Park Plazas (tree logo)" - 4 1/2' x 3' (?), 5' off ground (?)
- Deliverables for Consulting Phase of the PP Sign Replacement Project:
 - * Design for cul-de-sac signs several examples with design and materials to be used
 - * Cost estimate for each cul-de-sac sign break out difference in cost for creating 36 individual name graphics (ie: apple, lamp, lightning) as opposed to simply using the Park Plazas tree logo on each sign
 - * Prototype or small-scale model
 - Design for WELCOME sign and cost estimate
 - * Estimate for installation of all signs
 - * Lighting options

What about forks in Ristra, Tulipan, Cisne, Esmeralda?


Navigation at night is extremely difficult.

- Complements the distinguishing features of our homes and neighborhood aesthetics








PRIORITY GOALS

- Lights mounted on top




PHASE SEVEN - DESIGN BY ARTMAN

 - mounted on railroad ties to retain original theme




PHASE EIGHT - MOCKUPS
